ABOUT THE COURSE

Business process modelling is an essential component of Business Process Management (BPM) as well as other business process improvement initiatives such as business process redesign, systems development, quality management and continuous process improvement.

In this course you will learn to model business processes using **Business Process Model and Notation Version 2.0** (**BPMN 2.0**). BPMN 2.0 is in the forefront of business process mapping and modelling because it is understandable by both business and technical people.

BPMN is rigorous in its approach and has been standardised by the Object Management Group (OMG). It is supported by a number of leading business process modelling tools as well as BPM systems and has become the de facto standard for BPM.

This course is aligned with the **Guide to the Business**Process Management Body of Knowledge (BPM CBOK®)

Version 4.0.
